

# Push for paths in Wattle Bank

THE Wattle Bank Community Group is pushing to reduce speed limits on side roads and introduce footpaths.

The group is advocating to VicRoads to decrease the limit from 100km/h, the default limit for many of the dirt and sealed roads in the small town.

There are about 70 properties in Wattle Bank, although community group secretary

Wendy Bulbulian says there are no footpaths or tracks.

"We have nothing at all, no community space, no parks," she said.

"We'd like to see walking tracks in the town and on the side of the roads.

"There's so much development going on and there are a few businesses in town."

The community group has become more active in recent months, holding a clean-up

event on Australia Day.

The group will hold its AGM on Monday, May 7 at the Kongwak CFA rooms.

"Most people around here are on five or 10 acre blocks so some are a bit secluded.

"The meeting's open to anyone who wants to get to know their neighbours or become part of the committee."

The meeting will start at 7pm and include guest speakers from the CFA.
