# PREPARING FOR SUMMER

**CFA** Spring offers a great opportunity to be out cleaning up your property before summer. Prepare now before restrictions come in but please don't burn on windy days. When you do burn, ensure you register your burn and don't leave it unattended.

Bass Coast Council offers fee-free green waste disposal period will start on 1 November and run for six weeks until 16 December 2018, and provides the perfect opportunity to clean up prior to summer and the fire season. During the period, you can dispose of domestic quantities of green waste at the Grantville, Wonthaggi and Inverloch Transfer Stations, and Cowes Recycling Bank. Weeds and plants that cannot be mulched such as Blackberry, English Ivy, Agapanthus, Mirror Bush and palm fronds are not accepted free of charge however these can go in your kerbside Organics (green lid) bin. ## **Aphid Spray**

1 rhubarb leaf, cut into pieces 2 cloves of garlic peeled and cut up in slices Combine with 2 litres of warm water Cover with glad wrap for 3

Strain and keep the liquid only.

Use your new spray at 40ml to 1 litre of water

Lasts for up to 2 months



#### Ingredients

3 egg yolks 2 1/2 Tbsp caster sugar 2 tsp lemon zest(finely grated) 50ml lemon juice 25gms salted butter chopped

Method: Whisk yolks and sugar in a small saucepan until pale. Place over a low heat, add lemon zest, juice and butter and whisk until frothy. Stir continuously for 5 minutes or until curd coats the back of a spoon. Transfer to a sterilised jar and keep in the fridge for 4 weeks


