No plastic bags in Organics or Recycling Bins



No e-waste or batteries in any bin. These can be recycled at most Waste Facilities

Cardboard belongs in your recycling bin!

Cardboard disposed of in your Recycling bin is turned into new cardboard products. While your Organics bin can accept a small amount of nude cardboard (eg. pizza boxes) there must be **absolutely no** sticky tape, staples or glossy cardboard. It's best to put cardboard into your Recycling bin. If you generate more cardboard waste than your kerbside bin can tolerate, it is **free** to recycle cardboard at Council's waste facilities.

Putting your bin out

Please ensure that your bin is out for collection no earlier than 24 hours before your collection day and that it is returned to your property within 24 hours of collection. For some residents or property owners, asking neighbours for assistance or engaging a property maintenance contractor may be required to meet these obligations. If strong winds or storms are forecast, please put your bin out as close to your usual collection time as possible to reduce the risk of your bin contents being spilled. Storms and adverse weather may result in collection delays.
